2019 sees Led Zeppelin - the 70's iconic rockband - celebrate the 50th anniversary of their debut album. That release - as well as all their subsequent albums - dazzled and literally shook the world of music, and created a whole new direction in rock'n'roll. Their music is now being revisited by a band consisting of some of the most in demand players on the Danish and European jazz scene.

Drummer/composer Karsten Bagge, rediscovering his own personal musical roots, wrote the arrangements, and the band gives a modern, jazz inspired take on the songs, which perhaps more than any other collection of songs, has been the soundtrack of a whole generation.

While in no way trying to surpass the raw energy of Led Zeppelin, as shown both live and in the studio, the band strives to give the music a whole new expression, where the listener can expect to encounter both familiar tones and surprising new directions of the classic songs.
